NEW TO HOME SCHOOLING



coordinate with teachers

Follow learning plans, but contact your child's teacher to facilitate their learning and understand what's expected of them, and of you. Build a workflow that works for your child and your family.



...but be flexible

Changes happen. Even if you have lesson plans and study schedules, home schooling is new for many. Allow time to adjust and change things round if you need to.



set a schedule...

You may follow a lesson plan, but you and your child should set how you'll work with it. If possible, set up study periods and break times that work with your child and family.



encourage your child's natural interests

If your child is engaged and motivated by certain topics, schedule these during times where you can take a mental break or focus on other work.

connect with parents

Co-ordinate group chats or mailing lists. Talk with other parents going through home schooling for the first time, share stories, get tips. You aren't going through it alone.
